**Would you like to be paid to take part in a citizens' jury?**

**Citizens' Juries Community Interest Company, a not-for-profit company, is inviting applications from members of the public who would like to take part in an exciting new project commissioned by a national and a regional health agency to explore what citizens think about sharing patient data.**

**If selected, you will be part of a "citizens' jury" of 18 adults who will meet together in central Manchester between 09.30 and 17.15 on 17-19 January 2018. The jury will be given relevant information, and work together over the three days to answer important questions about how patient data should be used. **You do not need any particular skills, knowledge or experience to be a member of the citizens' jury. No CV is required. People will be selected so that the jury comprises a cross-section of the public.**

**You can apply if:**

- **You are 18 or over;**
- **You have been a resident of England for over the past year;**
- **You do not work in the NHS or have special knowledge or experience of health records;**
- **You can commit to all 3 days of the jury, from 17 to 19 January, 09.30 to 17.15 each day, in central Manchester.**

**If selected, you will be paid £300 for your time on the last day of the jury by Citizens Juries CIC cheque. You will also be paid £25 in cash as a travel allowance on the first day.**

**To apply to take part in the jury, press the "Next" button below, and complete this on-line survey form by no later than midnight, Thursday 30 November 2018. It takes about 5 minutes to complete.**
